# Family Law Programs

- Vision for Justice Collaborative
  - Assists immigrant and refugee victims of crime with civil legal issues such as divorce, custody, support, and restraining orders.
- Shriver Custody
  - Provides legal assistance in domestic violence restraining order and child custody matters.
  - Helps self-represented litigants with custody matters.
  - Walk-In clinic
    - Central Court House, 1100 Union Street, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, San Diego
    - M-Th 8:30 – 12:00
  - Applicants may be eligible for legal advice, limited scope (drafting), or direct representation.

# Restraining Order Clinics

- Walk-in assistance for victims of domestic violence, civil harassment, and elder abuse with completing and filing restraining orders.

# Pre-Petition Legal Services

- Probate Guardianship
  - Helps obtain guardianships for children who have been abused, neglected, or abandoned.
    - Walk-in clinic Tuesdays & Thursdays, 1–4 PM at 110 W A St, San Diego.
  - Helps parents who have children subject to a probate guardianship.
  - Accepts CWFB referrals and self-referrals

# Education Rights Program

- Provides representation for foster youth or families receiving Child and Family Well-Being Services in education-related matters.

# Microbusiness & Nonprofit Support Program

- Offers legal services for low-income entrepreneurs and nonprofits on business formation, contracts, and intellectual property.

# Housing Programs

- Offers a Remote Eviction Notice Legal Clinic for tenants who have received eviction notices but have not been sued.
- Provides legal information and assistance in residential eviction cases. Walk-in clinic Tues–Thurs, 8:30–1:30 PM at Vista Courthouse.



# Record Relief for Survivors

- Represents human trafficking survivors to remove nonviolent offenses from criminal records resulting from their victimization.

# HIV/AIDS Legal Services Program

- Provides legal help for low-income San Diegans living with HIV/AIDS in areas like benefits, housing, and discrimination
