



High School Equivalency Exam Preparation

The HSE course is designed for active and engaged learners seeking their high school equivalency / GED (General Education Degree).

Face to face or Zoom instruction with qualified instructors, specializing in test preparation

Open enrollment throughout each 16 week class session

- Practice Test and GED Test vouchers available for students that meet requirements
- Course taught in Spanish is available


