- No Probation Status
- No Court Fees over \$499.99

Applicant must demonstrate willingness to:

- Demonstrate the desire to enroll
- Function as a part of a group
- Live in a multi-cultural environment
- Follow rules and expectations
- Contribute to a positive center culture

Undergo a full WELLNESS CHECK/PHYSICAL exam



THE TABE TEST

If you test below an 8<sup>th</sup>-grade level, you will be schedule to academic classes and tested every 90 days, even if you have a HSD/GED



Share a dorm room and keep it clean



Get involved in Community/Leadership



Follow rules and your schedule

Be on time  
Attend all assigned classes  
Wear uniform

The program includes up to two years of education & career technical training with an additional year IF accepted into an advanced training or college program.



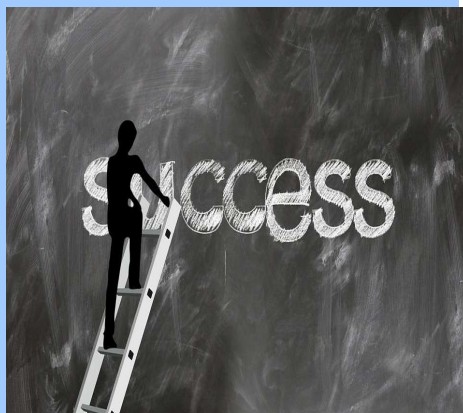
The training day is Monday through Friday  
8:00 am – 4:00 p.m.



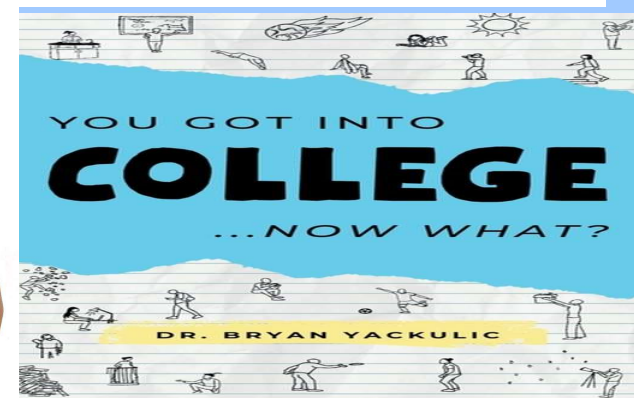
Students are allowed to go home on the weekends but need to provide their own transportation. Residential students cannot keep a car on campus.

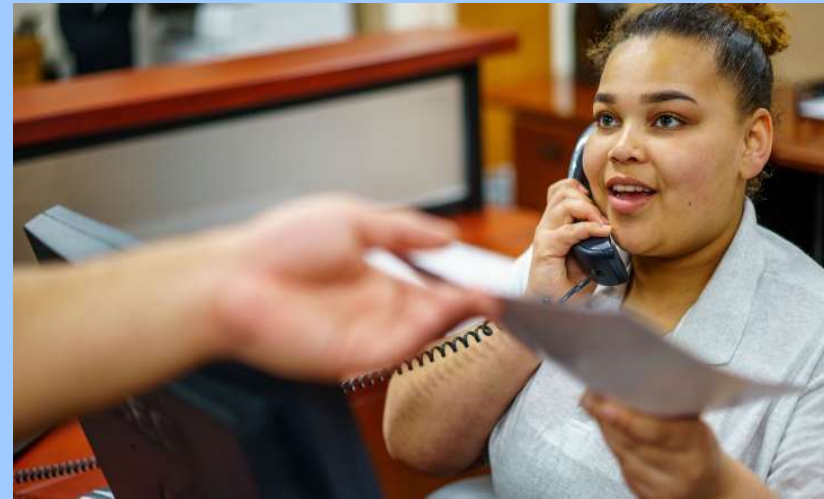

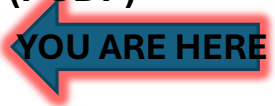

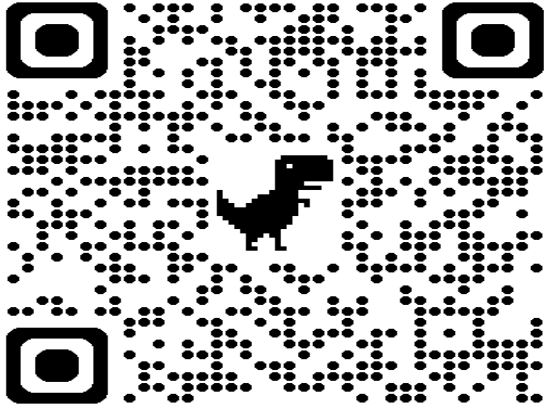
